- When withdrawing funds from ATM machines or over-the-counter services, a COT charge may be applicable. This charge is aimed at covering the costs associated with processing total withdrawal request.
- Similar to funds transfers, the COT charge for withdrawals may vary depending on your account type and the specific amount of funds in each user accounts.

Notification and Consent:

Customers will be informed of the applicable COT charges at the time of initiating the funds transfer or withdrawal request. By proceeding with the transaction, customers provide their consent to each Fee payments.
